A few reasons to stay

1. Take one of the most scenic coastal routes, Clarence Drive to Rooi Els and beyond.
2. Visit Kogelberg Biosphere Reserve, South Africa's first UNESCO declared biosphere, recognised for its rich biodiversity.
3. Hike, swim, river raft, go black water tubing, mountain bike or stayover in the glass fronted eco cabins in Kogelberg Nature Reserve.
4. Take pleasure in fynbos while hiking in Kleinmond Coastal and Mountain Reserve.
5. Stopover at Endangered African Penguin Colony situated at Stony Point, Betty's Bay – also an old Whaling Station. Educational pictures at On the Edge Restaurant.
6. Relax at Harold Porter National Botanical Garden. Have a picnic, buy fynbos plants, take a walk.
7. Visit Rooisand Nature Reserve to spot the Kleinmond Wild Horses.
8. Swim, surf or relax at many beaches. Kleinmond is a Blue Flag beach.
9. Hire a canoe at Kleinmond Pleasure Boats.
10. Sit under the shade of "Die Preekboom" Kleinmond Lagoon.
11. Crosses at Palmiet Beach – commemorating the sunken The Gustav Adolf.
12. Say hello to Southern Right Whales from June – Mid December.
13. Play golf at 18 hole Arabella Golf Course or Kleinmond 9 hole course.
14. Sandboarding at Blesberg, dune 250m tall with a potential run of +400 meters.
15. Bird watching – from Rooisand to birding-hotspot of Rooi Els.
16. Enjoy sundowners and view Hangklip Lighthouse at legendary Hangklip Hotel.
17. Scuba dive, angle or kite surf along the coast.
18. Explore interesting galleries, arts, crafts and curio shops at Kleinmond Harbour and Pringle Bay.
19. Visit Pringle Bay Alpacas at 1015 Elizabeth Road.
20. Enjoy a ride at Kleinmond Bike Park offering a Jump, Skills, Pump & Kiddies Track.



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
